<b>Access Keyboard Shortcuts</b>	
<b>Tab (or enter)</b>	Moves one field to the right.
<b>Shift+Tab</b>	Moves one field to the left.
→	Moves the cursor one field to the right. In Edit mode, moves cursor through text.
←	Moves the cursor one field to the left. In Edit mode, moves the cursor through text.
↑	Moves the cursor up one row.
↓	Moves the cursor down one row.
<b>Home</b>	Moves the cursor to the first field in the current row.
<b>End</b>	Moves the cursor to the last field in the current row.
<b>Page Down</b>	Moves the cursor down one screenful.
<b>Page Up</b>	Moves the cursor up one screenful.
<b>Ctrl+Home</b>	Moves the cursor to the first field in the first row.
<b>Ctrl+End</b>	Moves the cursor to the last field in the last row.
